IMPORTANT NOTES:

- (1) All TAs are required to have completed courses in *Lab Safety (SC 1807)* and *WHMIS (SC 1808)*. If this is not already completed, you will have within 30 days of your appointment to do so. TAs can enroll in these courses (free of charge) as per the normal university course registration process. These course take a couple of hours to complete.
- (2) Priority to assigning TAs will be given to those currently enrolled within their program time limits. Those applying for a TA who are outside their program of study may be allocated a TA subject to budgetary approval.
- (3) Priority to assigning TAs will be given to graduate students enrolled in the Chemistry department. Students who apply from outside the Chemistry program will only be considered once all graduate students in Chemistry have been assigned.
- (4) It is the responsibility of the applicant to inform the department of any change in their availability by resubmitting this form prior to the submission deadline stated below.
