The Faculty of Education invites applications from individuals interested in teaching the following undergraduate course in the **Fall Semester 2024**.

Subject to budgetary restrictions and sufficient enrolments, appointments will be made on a course by course basis and will not entail any obligation to conduct research or to perform any administrative service for Memorial University. Appointments will be made in accordance with the provisions in the MUN-LUMUN Collective Agreement. Course design and evaluation methods for all courses will be in accordance with the Faculty of Education regulations and the Memorial University Calendar. **This course is externally funded and will involve teaching for students at Nunavut Arctic College.**

**Course Title:** ED 3543: Language Arts in the Primary/Elementary School II (1.0 Course Weights)

**Course Schedule:** TBD

**Campus Location:** Remote (Nunavut Arctic College)

**Course Description** This course provides students with a social-psychological perspective on children's learning to read, reading and reading to learn. Students will explore current and traditional models of the reading process and the importance of home/school/community contexts for fostering literacy learning. Students will apply instructional strategies for children's learning of story, book and print concepts, word identification, fluency, vocabulary development and comprehension for a variety of texts.

**Qualifications:** will possess a Master's degree with course work in the science of reading and structured literacy programs, supplemented by wide-ranging current experience in teaching reading at the primary/elementary level and in additional language contexts. The successful applicant will demonstrate extensive specialized knowledge of current theories, methods, and practices in reading instruction.
