

## ENGLISH

The English program at Grenfell Campus, Memorial University allows you to work toward a Bachelor of Arts with a major or honours in English and a minor in another subject area.

We offer education in English literature, creative writing, and film studies within the framework of a liberal arts degree program.

Grenfell's English program includes key courses that give you a strong understanding of the essential aspects of literary analysis. The courses are grouped into specific areas of inquiry: English Core Courses, Applied and Experiential Courses, Nationally Identified Literatures, Post-1900 Courses, Pre-1900 Courses, Women Writers, and Special Topics.

In addition to the English program requirements, English majors will also complete an eight-course minor in another subject. Minor programs are offered in areas including Social/Cultural Studies, Geography, and Historical Studies.

The Honours Bachelor of Arts in English offers greater concentration in the discipline and necessitates a higher level of academic achievement than is required for the completion of a general degree. Honours students will also complete a thesis project at the end of their degree.

### Why study English at Grenfell?

If you love to read and write, the English program at Grenfell will expand your creativity, imagination, and critical thinking. There is a particular focus on creative writing, experiential learning, and diversity and inclusivity. Our professors provide you with the analytical and writing skills required to analyze identity, culture, world events, and your own daily encounters in a thoughtful and engaged manner.

Our faculty specializes in a breadth of literary areas, including Medieval literature, Renaissance literature, film studies, Canadian literature, American literature, British literature, pride literature, environmental literature, creative writing, and critical theory.

### Career Opportunities

Graduates of Grenfell's English program are equipped to work in a variety of fields and go on to pursue diverse careers in education, law, journalism, copywriting, public relations or communications, and government service.
