The award is valued at \$500.00 and is given to a full-time undergraduate student in good academic standing with a cumulative average of 65% or higher. The undergraduate student must have a chronic disability or illness which can be either mental or physical.

Candidates are also asked to briefly describe their campus and community involvement and include documents verifying their involvement.
