- iv. "Non-Degree Student (Undergraduate Grenfell)" Academic Program;
- v. "Grenfell" for Campus.

3. APPLY: Once you're signed in to your account, create a new **application**. Under the "**Undergraduate**" category, select the type of application that best applies.

4. COMPLETE all tabs of the Application:

5. SUBMIT:

Hit "**Submit**" and pay the Undergraduate application fee (\$60 for Canadian residents and \$120 for international students).

This must be completed before attaching supplemental information.

6. REGISTER:

NOTES:

- 1. If you are an international student, proof of English proficiency may be required. Please contact gcstudy@mun.ca to discuss additional requirements.
- **2.** Registration as a non-degree student is open to those aged 21 or older, and applicants will be required to provide a proof of age document.
