Before you leave for the holiday break, we'd like to share a few important reminders to help keep our campuses safe and energy efficient during this time.

Reminders before leaving for holiday break

- Close and lock all windows, including offices, labs, etc.
- Set thermostats to 18°C (65°F).
- Power down and unplug computers and electronic equipment.
- Remove perishable food or beverages from desks, offices and refrigerators.
- Unplug all small appliances such as kettles, toasters, etc.
- Ensure any holiday decorations are unplugged.
- Secure any loose outdoor items or bring indoors.

Laboratories

- Power down and/or disconnect laboratory equipment if possible.
- Fully close all fume hood sashes.
- Turn off gas, water, electricity, vacuum and compression lines and heating apparatuses if possible.
- Properly store chemicals in labs.
- Label, package and dispose of waste materials.
- Ensure regulated materials are secured at all times (i.e. nuclear substances, biohazards, etc.).
- Decontaminate any equipment or work areas.
- Ensure emergency contact information in the hazard identification sign on lab door is up-to date.
- Close and lock laboratory doors before leaving.
