- Visit the **Internationalization Office** website: <https://www.mun.ca/international/new-students/>.
- Complete the IO's **Arrivals Form here**, once you know you are traveling to Canada for your studies.
- Receive approval for your Study Permit from IRCC (Need help? [Our Immigration Advisors are here!](#))
- Make your **housing plan** 🏠 and book your flight! ✈️ (\*Don't forget: Securing a place to stay before you arrive is one of the most important steps to avoid last-minute challenges and high costs.)
- Update your travel and housing information by emailing [arrivals@mun.ca](mailto:arrivals@mun.ca).
- Catch up on last semester's **IO Welcome Info Sessions** on Youtube, and book an appointment with Arrivals Advisor at <https://www.mun.ca/international/contact-us/>.
- Learn about **important dates and deadlines** (University Diary).
- Download the Memorial Apps such as **MUN mobile, MUN Safe & Brightspace Pulse (D2L)**

- Get a mobile phone (info available in the **International Student Handbook**).
- Purchase a Metro buss pass (**m-Card**) to get around St. John's.
- Open a bank account (info available in the **International Student Handbook**).
- Get a government **Photo ID** or **Driver's License** (optional).
- Join the **IO Welcome Event** & check out **the IO's social activities** to enrich your campus life.
