“The Selective Experience – One Pager”

PURPOSE	Twelve (12) weeks to round out your medical learning experience.	
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NON TRADITIONAL - Progression to Post Graduate (P2P)

- 12 week integrated Selective – ‘Real Life’, tailored to you placement that will allow you to follow patients in the system
- Longitudinal generalist community based experience
- ONLY available in NL, NB and PEI
- Suggest a site!
- First come, first served basis – apply early!
- Separate P2P one-pager document with enhanced details

TRADITIONAL SELECTIVES

- Consists of four weeks each of Surgery, Rural Core and Non-Core

SURGERY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If choosing 4 consecutive weeks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can be completed as one 4 week placement in one subspecialty • Can be completed as 2 x 2 week back to back placements where the subspecialties chosen can be different • If choosing nonconsecutive 2 x 2 weeks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The subspecialty chosen does not have to be the same for both placements
RURAL CORE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 weeks in a rural site: population <50,000 and >1 hour drive from a population of >100,000 • Must reside in community for the duration of the placement • Not able to split rotation – must be 4 consecutive weeks in single core specialty (see below for Anes/EM exception) • If completing as Surgery: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only Orthopedics or General Surgery qualify as Rural Core • Must complete at least 8 weeks of Non-Surgery Selectives or Electives
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anesthesia / Emergency Medicine combination <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is the only approved combination for Rural Core
NON-CORE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two different 2 week rotations for Non-Core: 4 weeks in total • NOT Surgical and NOT completed in Core <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If completed in Core, cannot complete as Non-Core (as either Adult or Pediatrics) • If not completed in Core, can complete as Non-Core but can only complete one (either the Adult or Pediatric version) • Non-Core options at other schools are permitted
