3. Submit your CV.
4. Provide a reference letter from a professor or advisor that demonstrates your commitment to the following:
 - a. Improving the health system and harm reduction
 - b. Communication and team-based care skills
 - c. Integrity and respect for others
 - d. Joy in medical practice.
5. Complete this application form.
