

PoCUS Session Booking– Multidisciplinary Labs (MDL)

- Book date/ time required through MDL with Corinne Mercer, cfmercerc@mun.ca .
- Machines will not leave the MDL area unless permission is given.
- Booking priority goes to UGME teaching.
- We have 7 large labs and 4 smaller labs available for use for PoCUS session.
- There are ultrasound machines available for booking. We have 10 machines :
9 - SonoSite Edge II and 1 - SonoSite M-Turbo.
- If SPs are required for your session, these must be booked through the CLSC. There is a form on their website, <https://www.mun.ca/medicine/administrative-departments/clinical-learning-and-simulation-center-clsc/> . These requests are time sensitive and will have to be booked in advance.
- MDL has everything you will need to simulate a patient environment. We have: Beds, pillows, linen, stepstools, privacy screens, ultrasounds, etc. If there is something extra you would like to have for your session, please inquire when booking to determine if we can provide this for you.
- If a session includes learners scanning themselves / volunteers (not SPs), there are waiver forms which outline the guidelines to be followed during the session. These are provided by MDL when required.
- There is also an incidental finding form that may be filled out to give to a family doctor if there is an issue discovered during a session. These forms are available through MDL.
- All machines MUST be cleaned after use with appropriate cleaners (supplied).
- Any group, other than UGME, will be asked to bring their own gel.
- There will be a fee for any booking associated with a Workshop/ Course/ Training/ Conference etc. that charges a registration fee.
