Barrowman Travel Award in the Division of Community Health & Humanities

Eligibility:

These awards are made possible through a generous endowment from Ms. Gwen Barrowman. The income from this endowment will be used to provide a number of awards to graduate students pursuing a research program in the Division of Community Health & Humanities, so that they may present their research at relevant scientific conferences. Recipients will have demonstrated high academic standing and research potential. Applicants will also be eligible for funding from other sources (e.g. Research and Graduate Studies).

There will be one competition per year. Only students registered **full-time or part-time in a graduate program of the Division of Community Health & Humanities** are eligible to apply. To be eligible for an award, a student **must be presenting at the conference** and the **student's supervisor must be contributing to the cost of sending the student to the conference**. In any competition, if there are more applicants than awards, recommendations for awards will be based on the graduate grades and publication records of the applicants.

Each student will normally be eligible to receive only one award during his/her program. If sufficient funds are available, Ph.D. students will be eligible to receive a second award. However, priority will be given to first time applicants.
