- cover letter
- CV with a list of appropriate publications and/or presentations
- transcript(s) – unofficial is acceptable
- a research statement with progress to date (or anticipated research goals if just starting your research)
- supervisor (or main advisor) reference letter

Should a scholarship/award require an extra component, it will be listed below under **Application Process** and should be clearly identified as a component of that particular application (for example: *reference letter #2 for Dr. Noreen Golfman Graduate Award*).

### Ever Green Environmental Scholarship in Social Enterprise & Mental Health, in Memory of Edwin M. Drover

#### Eligibility:

This scholarship was established by a generous donation from Ever Green Environmental Corporation. It will be awarded annually to a **full-time graduate student**, in any discipline, participating in a work term or internship with an organization involved in **social enterprise or working in this field with a regional health authority**. Preference will be given to students working with an organization in which creating **self-sufficiency through training and/or employment of individuals with mental health issues** is a primary goal.

#### Application Process:

Applications should also include (and be clearly identifiable in your application package):
