

Jane Doe Award in Anti-Violence Research

Deadline: February 3, 2025 (apply to gradawards@mun.ca)

Eligibility: This award is in honour of all Jane Does, as well as one particular Jane Doe who bravely stood up for her rights and the rights of other survivors. Her recent actions have set a precedent that will positively impact all survivors of future gender-based violence cases in our province. It will be awarded annually to **any graduate student who is focusing their research or scholarly work on anti-violence in any subject area at Memorial University of Newfoundland**. Preference will be given to <u>indigenous</u> <u>women or indigenous gender diverse individuals</u>. Second preference will be given to non-indigenous women and non-indigenous gender diverse individuals. The recipient must meet the minimum academic requirements for an award

Application Process: The scholarship application consists of a single PDF in the following order:

- a cover letter,
- a one-page research statement,
- a CV,
- two letters of reference, and
- a current academic transcript
