June 1st (applications must be submitted by the students directly to sgs@mun.ca)

Eligibility:

Valued at a portion of the income on the endowment, the Award is designed to encourage and foster increased levels of scientific innovation at the **doctoral program level**, with the goal of enriching and diversifying the economy of Newfoundland and Labrador and beyond. To be eligible, candidates must be **full-time doctoral candidates** whose research is of a scientific nature and who have completed their comprehensive exams but not yet completed their thesis research. Applications are encouraged from graduate students in any of Memorial's faculties, schools or campuses.

Application Instructions:

Students must submit an application directly to the School of Graduate Studies by emailing sgs@mun.ca **no later than June 1st**. The scholarship application consists of:

- a covering letter,
- a one-to-two page description of how their research will go beyond knowledge generation to include innovation that may lead to commercialization of the outcomes of their research,
- a CV with list of appropriate publications and/or presentations,
- a current transcript (unofficial is acceptable),
- two reference letters
