Anthony is Tony's grandfather on his father's side. He is a 64 year old electrician who lives in the Town of St. James and has been married to his wife, Bride for 40 years. They have 4 children and 8 grandchildren. Bride has been a homemaker since they got married. He has worked in the machine works plant for more than 30 years and is close to retirement.

Anthony has decided to eat better and wants to become a vegetarian. He thinks he eats too much meat and that this can't be good on his cholesterol. He doesn't know what his cholesterol is, but his brother told him he should have it checked because it is in the family. His wife Bride may be more willing to cook vegetarian if she knows this will help his cholesterol.

Anthony is 5'9" and weighs 198 pounds. He has a waist measurement of 42 inches. His blood pressure is 130/84 and his heart rate is 75. His heart and lungs sound normal.
