Ratified clubs & societies receive funding from MUNSU in the Fall and Winter semesters, as well as access to the various resources MUNSU offers to ratified groups such as space booking, equipment rentals, bank account assistance, etc. Before a group can be ratified, they must apply for recognition status for two consecutive semesters. Recognized groups can also access many of the resources available to ratified groups.
