**Course Description:** PSYC 3830 Behavioural Endocrinology explores the behavioural effects of hormones and the question of how hormones act on the brain to influence behaviour. Topics include basic concepts in neuroendocrinology, reproductive behaviour (sexual and parental), sexual differentiation of the brain and behaviour, aggressive behaviour, and the neuroendocrinology of stress, including the effects of stress on the brain and behaviour.
