**Course Title:** PSYC 3802-001, Research Techniques in Behavioral Neuroscience

**Course Description:** PSYC 3802 allows students to increase their understanding of how knowledge is generated in the study of neuroscience and behavior. Students will visit various on-campus laboratories that are engaged in research relevant to these fields. In addition to observations and hands-on tutorials, readings, discussions, and writing assignments will strengthen students' understanding of the techniques used to answer specific research questions in neuroscience and behavior.
