Course Description: PSYC 2151 Health Psychology will explore the history, aims and future of health psychology. Topics covered will consider the contributions of a wide range of psychological theory within the context of psychosocial risk factors for illness, illness prevention, health promotion, and the health care system itself. These theories extend from rather individualistic notions of health and wellness (e.g., personality, attitudes, and behavior) to concepts associated with characteristics of the broader social environment (e.g., social support, economic challenges, and organizational factors).
