# What Motivates You to Use Cannabis?

My name is Molly Downey and I am a Psychology student at Memorial University.

For my master's thesis, I am conducting a study exploring postsecondary students' motivations for using cannabis.

**You may be eligible to participate if you:**

- 1) are 18-29 years old
