Duties and Responsibilities

The Teaching Assistant will be responsible for assessment and grading of written assignments for an undergraduate course in professional ethics. As assignments will be submitted through the course shell in BrightSpace, the assistant should be familiar with some of the administrative functions of course shells, including accessing student submissions and posting feedback and assessment.

Hours and Rate of Pay

This position will take place over the Spring 2024 semester and will require 30 hours. The rate of pay is \$24.93 per hour. The course will run Tuesday and Thursday mornings from June 25 to August 1, 2024 and the assistant may be required to attend from time to time.

Requirements

- Experience with grading and assessment of written assignments for undergraduate courses.
- Experience working with online course shells through BrightSpace.
- General knowledge of moral theory will be required for the assessment and grading of student work.
- Background in Philosophy would be beneficial.
- Must be a registered full-time graduate student at Memorial University.
