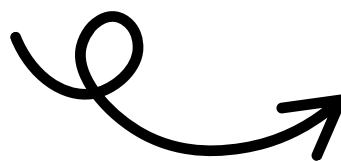
Step 1. Search St. John's Campus for the SDG posters
