

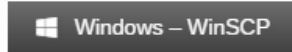



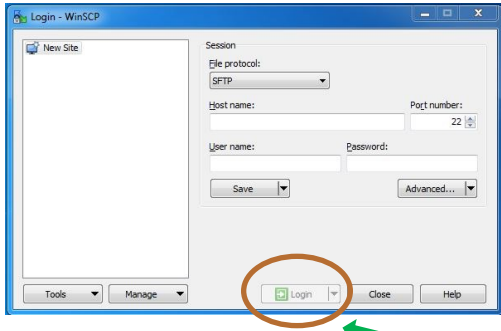
How to Access your Documents (in labnet/H drive) from Home or Office

1. Download WinSCP from The Commons homepage  <http://thecommons.mun.ca>

By clicking this button 



2. If WinSCP does not automatically open, double-click the WinSCP icon  on your desktop and follow these steps.



Fill-in/select the following information:

File Protocol: **SFTP**

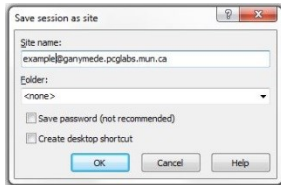
Host name: **ganymede.pcg labs.mun.ca**

Port: **22**

Username: **your Labnet username (e.g. jsmith)**

Password: **leave blank**

Click SAVE

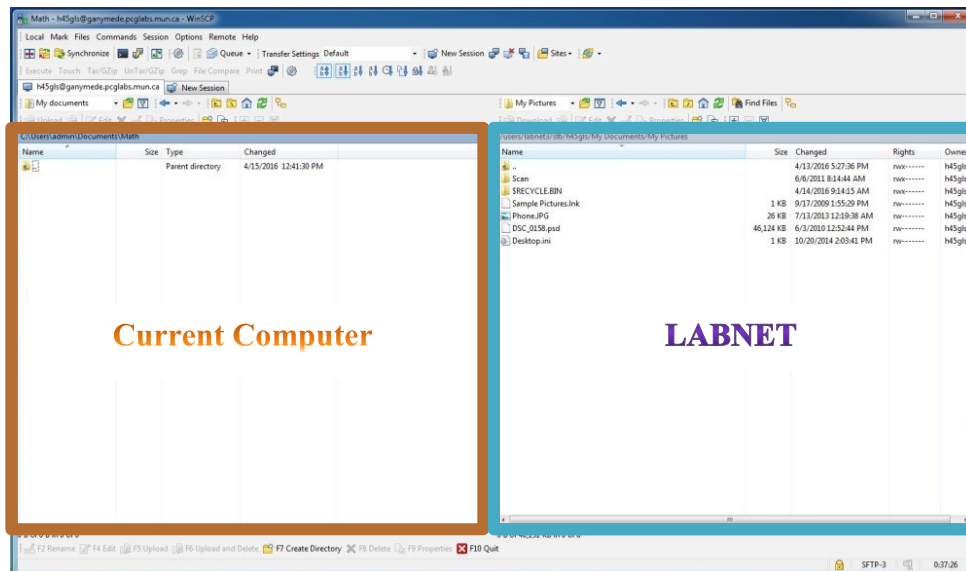


Click OK

Click Login

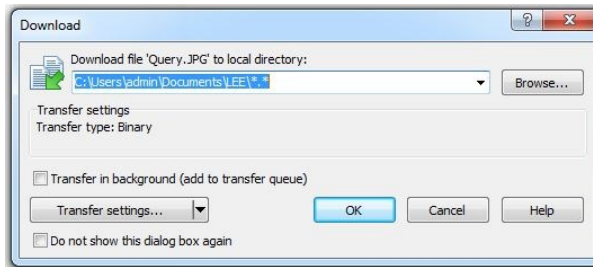
- a. If “WARNING: the server’s host key was not found...” appears, **CLICK YES**
- b. **ENTER LABNET PASSWORD** and **CLICK OK**

2. A screen similar to the following will appear. The files shown on the right (blue square) are on your labnet account (i.e. Ganymede – H drive) and the files on the left (orange square) display the files on the machine you are currently into.



3. On the Labnet side make sure you are in the **My Documents** folder. If not, double-click **My Documents**.

4. Click the file you want and press the **F5** key (or **click/drag/drop** the file you want from LABNET to the computer you are logged into or vice versa). Using **F5** will display a dialog box similar to the following.



BROWSE to where you want to place the file and click COPY.

5. When you are finished transferring files, click **COMMANDS** on the **WinSCP** menu bar and **QUIT** (or press the **F10** key).
