

Student Volunteer of the Year Nomination Form

Award Description

This award is presented to a Memorial student who has made exceptional volunteer contributions to the student community, the St. John's/provincial community, and/or a national or global community.

Nominee Criteria/Requirements

- The nominee must demonstrate a long-term commitment to volunteerism.
- The nominee must embody a positive, altruistic attitude towards volunteerism.
- The nominee must have demonstrated making a positive impact by taking on a volunteer role either on campus, in the community at large, or on a provincial, national, or global scale.
- The nominee must have demonstrated personal and/or professional growth through their volunteerism.
- The nominee must be in clear academic standing (currently hold a GPA of at least 2.0).
- The nominee must have been registered as a student for at least two out of the three previous semesters (including the current semester).

Other Notes

- A student can either self-nominate or be nominated by a colleague which can be a member of the campus community or the community at large.
- An individual cannot win the award two years in a row
- Full-time, part-time, undergraduate, and/or graduate students are eligible for this award.
